However, Brown is a green washer and a union buster! In the past few months, Brown has:
-Signed SB 4 which allows fracking in California;

-Pushed for the so-called "Peripheral Tunnels" in the Central Valley Delta, a project opposed by environmentalists;
-(At the behest of corporate developers) Pushed to water down CEQA, the California Environmental Quality Acti

He also issued a 60 day cooling off period during the recent BART strike thereby aiding the BART bosses in their ongoing campaign of vicious union busting. http://www.transportworkers.org/node/616

Brown and the Democrats have taken aim at public sector workers' pensions. They passed pension reform in September 2012 that raised most new workers' retirement age from 55 to 67, capped annual payouts at \$132,120 and mandated that 50 percent of pension funds must be paid out of workers' salaries.

Sierra Club is pushing for the eviction of the Albany Bulb which is a home to over 60 people. The city of currently has Albany has no long term services for the homeless.

We hope that this protest furthers the understanding that environmental issues and class struggle issues are interconnected. The same politicians, corporations, and bureaucrats that are compromising the rights of the lower and working class are also compromising our health and safety by having a hand in the destruction of the planet.

Several environmental groups will be protesting this sham award in protest of Brown's blue/green washing. We call for workers to join this protest in opposition to Brown's aiding of union busting!
